

FENCE PERMIT APPLICATION

REQUIREMENTS

- Submit completed **Building Permit** application with all of the following attached:
- **Include U.N.C.L.E. ticket number on application**
 - Contact **U.N.C.L.E.** at 1-800-432-4770 for ticket number.
- Completed **Homeowner Affidavit**
- **TWO** copies of **Survey** with the following included:
 1. **Fence Location**
State and highlight the location of the fence on each copy of the survey.
 2. **Fence Design**
State the design of the fence on each copy of the survey.
 3. **Fence Gates**
State the location of the fence gates on each copy of the survey.
 4. **Fence Height**
State the height of the fence at each location on each copy of the survey.
 5. **Fence Length**
State the total length of the fence and the length of each fence segment on each copy of the survey.
 6. State if a pool and/or spa is on the property on each copy of the survey.
- **Chain Link Fence Requirements**
 - Show compliance with the Chain Link Fence minimum requirements as set forth in Table 2224 of the Florida Building Code on each copy of the survey, or attach a copy of the table to each copy of the survey and highlight the items that apply to your job.
- **Wood Fence Requirements**
 - Show compliance with each of the following on each copy of the survey:
 1. **Wood Fence Post Hole**
The Wood Pressure Treated Post shall be embedded in a 2 foot deep by 10 inch diameter hole.
 2. **Wood Fence Post Size and Spacing**
The post for a wood fence shall be 4" x 4" pressure treated posts spaced no more than 4 feet apart for a 6' high fence/5 feet apart for a 5' high fence/6 feet apart for a 4' high fence.
 3. **Wood Fence Rails**
For a 6-foot high wood fence there shall be three horizontal 2" x 4" pressure treated rails between each post.
- **Product other than Chain Link or Wood Requirements**
 - Attach 2 copies of the Product Approval **or** 2 copies of signed and sealed engineered construction detail.
