CITY OF SUNRISE HURRICANE WILMA RESIDENT ASSISTANCE PROGRAM

The City of Sunrise established the Hurricane Wilma Resident Assistance Program to help provide relief to homeowners whose primary residence in Sunrise was significantly impacted by Hurricane Wilma. Based on the success of this program and the continued need in our community, the City has authorized a program expansion, as follows: Eligibility under this program is now available to single-family homes, townhomes, villas, or condominiums with a January 1, 2006 Total Property Assessment Value, as listed in the records of the Broward County Property Appraiser's Office (BCPA), of:

- \$155,000 or less; or
- \$200,000 or less prior to October 24, 2005 if BCPA subsequently reduced the total assessed property value due to Hurricane Wilma damage to an amount less than or equal to \$155,000.

Rental properties, including apartments, and dwelling units not occupied for primary residential use by the property owner, are not eligible.

To be eligible for assistance, the owner-occupant of a property must have been "significantly impacted" by the storm. Significantly impacted means the habitability of the residence was severely compromised for five months or longer. The period of impact must be due to the nature of the damage, rather than difficulty in obtaining the services of a qualified contractor, related insurance matters, or other factors that may have caused delays in the completion of repair work. You will need to provide supporting hurricane damage documentation (e.g., insurance claim forms, photographs, contractor estimates or receipts, building permits, etc.) to demonstrate that the property meets the eligibility requirements.

Notarized applications must be received or post-marked by April 30, 2008.
