The City's Roller Hockey Complex hosts a free night of Competitive Open Play each Tuesday, from 6:00 p.m. to 9:00 p.m. Two rinks are reserved for the inline action: one for adults 18 and up, and one for kids 17 and younger. (Children 17 and under must be accompanied by an adult.)

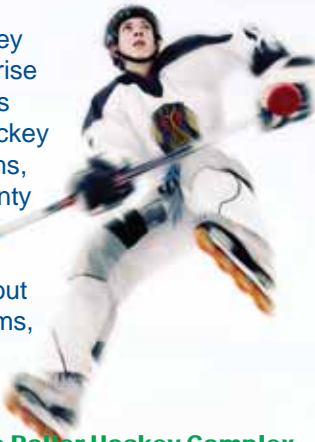
Bring your own skates and safety equipment. Sticks and pucks are provided, and limited goalie gear is available for loan. Trained staff is on site to organize teams.

A free Open Skating Session is also held on Tuesdays from 6:00 p.m. to 9:00 p.m., and on Saturdays from 10:00 a.m. to 5:00 p.m. Skaters of all ages and skill levels are welcome, and inline or traditional four-wheel skates may be used. (Bring your own! Skates are not available at the Complex.)

The Sunrise Roller Hockey Complex, located in Sunrise Commerce Park, features three regulation roller hockey rinks, as well as restrooms, vending facilities and plenty of parking.

# World-Class Tennis Returns to Sunrise

From March 16 to March 23, the City of Sunrise will host the prestigious **BMW Tennis Championship**. This exciting event provides South Floridians with a rare opportunity to see some of the top men's professional tennis players in action.

The tournament's home, Sunrise Tennis Club, has earned numerous accolades, including the United States Tennis Association's "Outstanding Facility" award.

The BMW Tennis Championship consistently draws a competitive field, thanks to its prime scheduling between the Pacific Life Open in Indian Wells, near Palm Springs, California, and the Sony Ericsson Open (formerly the NASDAQ-100 Open) in Key Biscayne. The 2007 tournament attracted a variety of dynamic, talented players,

including singles winner Gael Monfils of France. Monfils - then ranked #45 in the world and making his first Sunrise appearance - defeated rising star Andreas Seppi of Italy in three sets to take the BMW title.

Three-time French Open winner Gustavo "Guga" Kuerten of Brazil was among the many high-caliber players thrilling tournament spectators. In addition to Monfils, five other competitors ranked among the top 50 worldwide at the time of the tournament - including 2006 BMW defending champion Dmitry Tursunov of Russia, #27; and Slovakian Dominik Hrbaty, #25, who in 2006 was a finalist at the ATP Master Series Paris and reached the 4th round of the Australian Open. Marc Gicquel of France, #42, compiled his best career sea-

son last year, winning 17 matches on the circuit; while Germany's Florian Mayer, #45, earned a career-high 26 wins in 2006. Nicolas Massu of Chile, #50, was the winner of two Olympic gold medals in 2004.

The BMW Tennis Championship is the only Association of Tennis Professionals (ATP) event held in Broward County, and one of only three major tournaments in the state of Florida. The ATP is the organizer of the principal worldwide men's tennis tour.

FREE tickets must be picked up in person at the Box Office of the Sunrise Civic Center, located at 10610 West Oakland Park Boulevard, between February 12 and March 14. For residents' convenience, extended box office hours are Tuesday through Friday from 10:00 am to 7:00 pm, and Saturday from 10:00 am to 5:00 pm. FREE tickets will be distributed only during that time frame, and only while supplies last.

*\*Acceptable proof of residency includes a photo I.D. (a driver's license or state-issued identification card) AND one of the following: a utility bill (City of Sunrise, FPL, phone or cable), credit card statement or lease showing a Sunrise address.*
