# Remembrance Ceremony Marks September 11th Anniversary



**O**n Friday, September 11, at 8:30 a.m., the City of Sunrise will hold a Remembrance Ceremony to mark the anniversary of the 2001 terrorist attacks on America. All members of the community are invited to participate in this moving observance, which will be held in the Rotunda of the Sunrise Civic Center (10610 West Oakland Park Boulevard).

The Remembrance Ceremony will be hosted by the Sunrise City Commission and attended by members of City staff, including representatives from the Police and Fire-Rescue departments. Emergency apparatus will be on display, along with a piece of the World Trade Center. The ceremony will also feature remarks by distinguished speakers, the presentation of colors, instrumental and vocal selections, and light refreshments.

"This annual Remembrance Ceremony provides Sunrise with a means of honoring the heroes and the victims of September 11th," said Sunrise Mayor Roger B. Wishner. "This is a significant date in our history. It's important that our residents have an opportunity to come together to share and reflect."
