### 1 WESTERN UNION SPEEDPAY SERVICE

Sunrise is pleased to introduce this convenient service which enables you to pay your bill from home using an ATM/debit card, Visa or MasterCard, or check. You can access Western Union Speedpay online at [www.sunrisefl.gov/paymentoptions.html](http://www.sunrisefl.gov/paymentoptions.html) or by phone at 1-866-537-9041. Please note: A \$2.75 convenience charge is added to each Speedpay transaction.

### 2 AUTOMATIC PAYMENT SERVICE

### 3 PAY IN PERSON

Use the walk-up window or utility bill drop box at one of our three customer service locations – City Hall, Village Civic Center and New River Civic Center.
