A MESSAGE FROM THE MAYOR

We're excited to be embarking not only on a new year, but also a new decade, in the City of Sunrise. The term "20/20 vision" is synonymous with seeing clearly – having items in sharp focus. In much the same way, we're proud of our shared vision for the community in 2020. We are laser-focused on providing programs, services and facilities that meet your critical needs and enhance your quality of life.

We're off to a great start with our first event of the year – a family-friendly **Drive-in Movie** night at Markham Park (January 3). Our **Tunes 'N Trucks** Concert Series at the Sunrise Civic Center Amphitheater resumes in January and continues through May with a terrific variety of live music and food trucks.

We also look forward to hosting a daylong celebration of the arts in honor of **Martin Luther King, Jr. Day**. Events include a creative writing workshop for teens, an Art Gallery opening reception, and a concert featuring the award-winning Dillard Center for the Arts Jazz Ensemble – all at the Sunrise Civic Center on January 19. Tickets are free, but you'll want to reserve your spot early!

Many other popular annual events are returning – including a **Woofstock** festival for our furry friends (February 1 at Sawgrass Sanctuary), and a **Classic Car Show** (February 15 at Sunrise Athletic Complex). This year's **Taste of Sunrise** restaurant showcase (February 20 at the Sunrise Civic Center) is being presented in partnership with the Greater Sunrise Chamber of Commerce.

Our **Earth Day Festival** (March 28 at Sawgrass Sanctuary), now in its 12th year, will highlight the City's many sustainability efforts. In November 2019, Sunrise was honored by the National Wildlife Federation with the prestigious **Community Wildlife Habitat** certification – an accomplishment made possible with the help of residents, schools, businesses and organizations citywide. Late last year, we also celebrated the opening of two parks constructed or enhanced as part of the City's GO-bond funded improvements. If you haven't had the chance, be sure to explore **Nob Hill Soccer Club Park**, which now features an upgraded natural turf field, two synthetic turf fields with organic infill, and a new playground. Our totally-new **Sunrise Sportsplex** has a pinwheel of four youth baseball/softball fields constructed around a central concession stand and scorers' tower. There are also warm-up areas for pitchers and hitters, covered seating for fans, a large playground, and a multipurpose field. Stay tuned for announcements regarding the grand opening of additional recreation amenities in 2020!

This colorful publication, published annually since 2014, showcases the artwork of students in Sunrise elementary and middle schools. 

Meet Your Sunrise City Commission

The City of Sunrise operates under a Commission/Manager form of government. The Sunrise City Commission, which is comprised of a Mayor and four Commissioners, is the legislative and policy-making body of the City, responsible for approving the budget and providing strategic direction to staff. The City Commission appoints the City Manager, City Attorney, City Clerk, Police Chief, and members of City boards and committees.

The Mayor and City Commissioners are each elected at-large on a non-partisan basis and serve four-year terms. The City Commission represents the public interest; promotes prompt, courteous responses to citizen problems and concerns; provides clear leadership and direction; and assures the present and future fiscal integrity of the City.

The Sunrise City Commission is dedicated to serving the broad needs of the community. The Mayor and Commissioners provide careful and responsible judgment in the exercise of legislative duties, with the clear understanding that they are the people's representatives in setting policies and in determining levels and priorities of programs and expenditures.



Mayor Michael J. Ryan



Mike Ryan was first elected Mayor of Sunrise in August 2010. He earned a B.B.A., majoring in Finance, from The George Washington University, and a Juris Doctorate, summa cum laude, from Case Western Reserve University School of Law.

Mayor Ryan has served as a PTA President and an Executive Board Officer for the Sawgrass Elementary PTA; a volunteer coach over many years for youth soccer, baseball and flag football; volunteer coach for high school varsity girls soccer team; and two terms as Chair of the Education Advisory Board for the City of Sunrise.

Mayor Ryan has been or is a member, including chair and co-chair, of various county-wide boards and taskforces involving E911 Communications, Regional Planning, School Resource Officers, Domestic Violence, and School and Community Public Safety.

Mayor Ryan's work promoting scholastic and community based chess initiatives has been the subject of local, national and international news coverage. In 2015, Sunrise earned the national title of "Chess City 2015" by the United States Chess Federation.

Mayor Ryan is also a lawyer and partner in the law firm of Krupnick Campbell Malone Buser Slama Hancock & Liberman in Fort Lauderdale. His charitable works have included include running marathons for charity, helping gather goods and supplies to assist Haiti after the January 2010 earthquake, traveling to Haiti to volunteer after the earthquake, traveling overseas to volunteer at a U.S.O. Wounded Warrior Center, and a 900-mile bike ride to benefit, among others, wounded soldiers and their families.

Deputy Mayor Joseph A. Scutto



Joseph A. Scutto - a resident of Sunrise for over 40 years - grew up playing youth sports in Sunrise, attended Bair Middle School, and graduated from St. Thomas Aquinas High School. A Sunrise business owner since 1985, Scutto has served as a City Commissioner since 1997, and was most recently returned to office without opposition in 2016.

Deputy Mayor Scutto participates in the Broward County School Board's Partners in Education program that has helped students enter the workforce, and has sponsored numerous civic organizations and charities, including the American Cancer Society, Kaitlyn's Gift for Jackson Memorial Hospital, Dan Marino Foundation, Lutz Buddy Up, Joe DiMaggio Children's Hospital and the Paralyzed Veterans Association of Florida. He is the president of the Sunrise Italian-American Civic Association and has been an active member of several committees, including serving as Chair of the Florida League of Cities' Environmental Quality Committee.

Deputy Mayor Scutto currently serves on the National League of Cities' Community and Economic Development Steering Committee. He was also a chair of Broward County's Resource Recovery Board, and the previous Chair of the South Florida Regional Planning Council.

Deputy Mayor Scutto recently proposed a Free Recycled Paint program – unanimously approved by his colleagues – which would provide free exterior paint to Sunrise homeowners. He initiated the Youth Athlete of the Month program, which recognizes exemplary male and female student athletes. He also started and is a staunch supporter of expanding the City's School Resource Officer program to include grades K-12. Deputy Mayor Scutto is the owner of Scutto's Pizza Café/Drive Thru restaurant in Sunrise. He and his fiancée, Allison, are the proud parents of two girls, Kaitlyn and Alyse.





Assistant Deputy Mayor Neil C. Kerch

Neil C. Kerch was elected to the Sunrise City Commission in March of 2013, and re-elected in 2018. Assistant Deputy Mayor Kerch graduated cum laude from Florida Atlantic University in 2001 with a B.A. in Finance and Management. He received his J.D. in 2005 from the Shepard Broad Law Center at Nova Southeastern University. Assistant Deputy Mayor Kerch is admitted to the Florida Bar and the United States District Court of the Southern District of Florida. After being admitted to the Florida Bar, Assistant Deputy Mayor Kerch served as an Assistant Public Defender in Broward County. He currently works as a Trial Lawyer and Counselor of Law where he represents clients with legal issues in Broward, Miami-Dade, and Palm Beach Counties. Prior to embarking on his legal career, Assistant Deputy Mayor Kerch was employed in the Hotel/Restaurant industry.

Assistant Deputy Mayor Kerch has been a resident of Sunrise since 2004, where he has been active throughout our community. Assistant Deputy Mayor Kerch is a member of many professional associations and organizations. He has been a youth athletics coach for the children of Sunrise and, prior to being elected to the City Commission, served on the City's Leisure Services Advisory Board.

Assistant Deputy Mayor Kerch is married to Carmen, and they have one child.

Commissioner Mark A. Douglas



Commissioner Douglas is a 2006 graduate of Florida International University (FIU) College of Law with a Juris Doctorate in law. He practices Law throughout the State of Florida, including in the Federal Northern, Middle and Southern District Courts. He practices in the areas of Criminal Defense and Immigration Law, and handles matters related to unpaid minimum wage and overtime arising under the Federal Fair Labor Standards Act (FLSA). He has a Bachelor's Degree in Business Administration with honors, is a Realtor for over decade, and has managed his own Law practice since 2007. Before private practice, he worked as an Assistant State Attorney in Miami-Dade County, where he also previously served as a Certified Legal Intern while enrolled in Law School.

In Law School, he participated in Student Government, serving as president of the Black Law Students Association and as a member of the Law School's Board of Advocates, and was named to the Dean's List of Scholars.

He has been involved in many community activities, frequently providing pro bono services to indigent clients, providing free legal advice during Citizenship drives within Broward County, acting as a mentor to young law students and lawyers, and has served as treasurer of the Jamaican American Bar Association. He has served on the Board of four homeowners associations, and continues to serve as President of his community association board for over a decade.

He was a member of the Broward County Consumer Protection Board, The City of Sunrise Economic Development Advisory Board, the City's Bicycle and Pedestrian Advisory Board - which he chaired for two terms - and the City's Board of Zoning Adjustment.

In 2019, he served as Deputy Mayor and is the City's representative on the Board of the Broward League of Cities. At the statewide level, he serves on the Board of Trustees of the Florida Municipal Insurance Trust (FMIT); nationally, he is a member of the National League of Cities' Finance, Administration and Intergovernmental Relations Federal Advocacy (FAIR) Committee. He is a member of the Broward County Bar Association, serving on their mentorship committee.

Commissioner Douglas and his family have resided in Sunrise for over 18 years.



Commissioner Lawrence A. Sofield

Lawrence Sofield was appointed to the City Commission on February 17, 2009, and was elected by voters in November 2010. He was returned to office without opposition in 2014, and re-elected in 2018.

Since becoming a Sunrise resident in 1992, Commissioner Sofield has been an active and involved member of the community. As the founder and past president of the East Sunrise Residents Association, he has worked to boost safety and expand recreation opportunities in his neighborhood. In 2008, in an effort to further increase civic involvement, he founded the Central Sunrise Residents Association.

Commissioner Sofield is an advocate for quality education: He currently serves on the Village Elementary School Advisory Council, and is a past member of the Broward County School Board's Diversity Committee. He is also a past member of the Sunrise Leisure Services Advisory Board, and has been a volunteer coach in the City's t-ball and youth basketball leagues since 2003.

In 2019, Commissioner Sofield was elected to serve as Member At-Large on the Executive Committee of the Broward Metropolitan Planning Organization (Broward MPO), which has followed the mission to collaboratively plan, prioritize, and fund the delivery of diverse transportation options since 1977. The Commissioner has served in related advisory roles with the Broward MPO since 2010.

Commissioner Sofield is a licensed real estate agent and the president and founder of RealPost, Inc. - a successful Sunrise-based business. He is married with four children and three grandchildren.

Sunrise Digs Owls!

Here's why we give a hoot...

As outlined in our Sustainability Action Plan, Sunrise strives to protect vital resources – including water, air, and natural areas – and to promote a culture of sustainability in our community.

Our Be a Butterfly Hero program advances those goals by supporting biodiversity and habitat. Butterflies aren't the only creatures that benefit, however! By encouraging the planting of native habitat gardens we are providing vital natural connective corridors and important food sources for our other local species as well. One such species is the burrowing owl.

At about nine inches in height, the burrowing owl is one of the smallest owls in Florida. A burrowing owl has distinct yellow eyes, a white chin, and unusually long legs, which allows it to peer over the landscape. Burrowing owls are also different from other owls because they are active during the day. Referred to as "Florida's natural pesticide," burrowing owls eat grasshoppers, beetles, cockroaches, and other insects. They will also eat small lizards, snakes, frogs, and mice.

As a "threatened" species, Florida burrowing

owls are protected by state and federal laws. They face many dangers – but one of the biggest is the loss of habitat. Unfortunately, there's a shortage of open land.

Recently, we've had owls make homes on City recreation fields, requiring us to close them. We wanted to find a way to help the owls and keep our fields in use, so we partnered with Project Perch – a South Florida Audubon Society program (browardaudobon.org/project-perch).



Over the past year, Sunrise and Project Perch have teamed up to install signs and barriers around burrows, train City staff to maintain the burrowing owl habitats, and develop education initiatives. The City is also working with Project Perch to provide artificial burrows in parks that have recreation fields. These artificial burrows are cheap to create, can be installed by volunteers, and provide a "home upgrade" that hopefully will entice the owls to move from and stay off of our play areas.

Want to learn more about burrowing owls and help keep them safe? Here are a few owl-friendly recommendations:

-  Read *Buffy the Burrowing Owl*
-  Watch *Hoot*
-  Plant native Florida vegetation
-  Maintain a safe distance (at least 20 feet away) and do not disturb the burrows
-  Reduce pesticide use
-  Visit www.sunrisefl.gov/green and sign up for our Good and Green eNews

Sunrise is a Community Wildlife Habitat

At our Cultural Festival in November, the City of Sunrise was recognized by the National Wildlife Federation (NWF) as a Community Wildlife Habitat – a designation we've been working to achieve since 2016! We accelerated our certification efforts in 2019 with help from the Broward Habitat Connectivity Project – a collaboration with NatureScape Broward and the National Wildlife Federation, funded by a grant from the Community Foundation of Broward. The Project enabled us to host multiple community workshops and plant giveaways, and to complete several school garden projects – all with the help of volunteers!

Sunrise is currently home to over 200 wildlife habitats, from homes to schools and common areas (such as local businesses and City properties). The Community Wildlife Habitat certification shows that our residents embrace living with nature, and demonstrates the City's commitment to implementing the Sunrise Sustainability Action Plan. Each HHW disposal event takes place on a Saturday from 9:00 a.m. to 1:00 p.m.:

GO Bond Update:

Improvements to Parks and Recreation Facilities Continue

On Election Day in 2014, more than 70% of Sunrise voters approved the City's general obligation (GO) bond referendum. Thanks to this overwhelming resident support, Sunrise is able to fund improvements to parks and recreation facilities in neighborhoods citywide.

The map shown here provides a quick visual overview of work being funded by GO Bonds. On the next two pages, you'll find more in-depth information about projects currently under construction.

We will continue to update you on our progress in upcoming issues of Horizons. We also invite you to visit www.sunrisefl.gov/park-bonds for additional information - including photos and renderings - for all of our projects. (Please keep in mind that renderings are conceptual, and that design details may change over the course of a project.)

You can find project information – and knowledgeable staff members – at City events, too. Look for our GO Bond tent at Woodstock on February 1 and the Earth Day Festival on March 28 – both at Sawgrass Sanctuary – and at every Tunes 'N Trucks concert, January through May, at the Sunrise Civic Center!

COMPLETED

- 1 **12th Street Park** – a new neighborhood green space – was constructed on formerly vacant land.
- 2 **Flamingo Park** was renovated to add a new meeting hall, shaded basketball courts, fitness stations, a splash pad, and a second batting cage. The existing meeting facility was renovated and the playground was improved.
- 3 **Bicycle lanes** were constructed along NW 44th Street from Pine Island Road to the SAC entrance at NW 117th Avenue.

- 4 **Nob Hill Soccer Club Park** re-opened in November 2019 following a complete renovation. The facility now features two new synthetic turf fields, an improved natural turf field, and a music-themed tot lot. Nob Hill Clubhouse received a new roof and HVAC system.
- 5 **Sunrise Sportsplex** – the city's newest athletic amenity – opened in December 2019. The park features a pinwheel of youth baseball/softball fields, warmup areas, a concession stand/scorer's tower, a multi-purpose field, and a large playground.

SUNRISE CIVIC CENTER

The Sunrise Civic Center expansion project is nearing completion. The Athletic Club is doubling in size and will now offer two floors of equipment. The Civic Center will also gain new racquetball courts; a second full-size gymnasium with an elevated indoor walking track; a new game room; new multipurpose program space; enhanced security features; a centrally-located reception area; and a covered point of entry convenient to the parking lot.

WELLEBY PARK

The Welleby Park expansion includes the addition of Sunrise's first municipal dog park, with areas for large, small, and tiny dogs. Also new to Welleby Park will be a Safety Town play/learn area, a nature-themed splash pad, a relocated and enhanced playground, and a lakeside promenade. Additional Flexi-Pave pathways will be constructed, and the existing meeting hall will be expanded to accommodate programs and rentals for up to 100 people. There will be additional parking throughout, as well as enhanced lighting and security features.

VETERANS PARK

This new park will feature a plaza with flags and monuments in tribute to the U.S. Military Service Branches. Additional amenities will include an accessible playground, a meditation labyrinth, a Remembrance Pavilion, and a restroom building. Reserved parking will be provided for combat-wounded Veterans.

CITY PARK

Crews broke ground on the City Park construction project in August 2019. As part of this complete redesign and renovation, the existing ball fields will be replaced with a large green space surrounded by a walking path. Three outdoor covered basketball courts will replace the two existing uncovered courts, and the existing tennis courts will be refurbished. A plaza will be added to include a splash pad, a new playground, a maintenance building, and restrooms – and a small stage will be constructed for special events. Parking will be expanded and lighting and security features will be added.

LIGHTNING PREDICTION SYSTEM

The City has taken certain precautions to minimize the potential for lightning related injuries. The Thor Guard Lightning Prediction and Warning System has been installed to provide protection from lightning disasters for the public. When the Thor Guard system sounds (15 second horn blast), the outdoor facility must be cleared of all patrons, who must seek and remain in buildings or vehicles until the all clear signal sounds (3 short horn blasts).

It is recommended that park patrons seek a sheltered area, such as buildings, vehicles or other fully enclosed structures. Patrons should not seek refuge in or near dugouts, trees, fences, tot lot equip-

ment, light and telephone poles, umbrellas, metal objects, etc. This policy shall apply to all programs and facilities operated by the City of Sunrise. Individuals who disregard this policy may be subject to arrest for trespassing.

The Thor Guard system is in operation Monday through Sunday, 8:00 am to 10:00 pm at the following locations: Sunrise Civic Center, SAC, Welleby Park, City Park, Roarke Hall, Nob Hill Soccer Club, Flamingo Park, Oscar Wind Park, Sawgrass Sanctuary Park, Sportsplex, Sunrise Tennis Club, Springtree Golf Club, Piper Field and Welleby Pool.
